Texas United for Kids

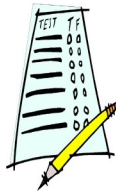

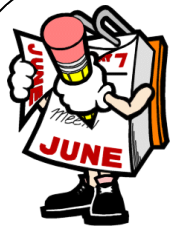

BOO Grams

Teacher's Corner

Understanding math is such an important skill. From the beginning of school in pre-k/kindergarten, students begin building a foundation from which all future math skills will be learned. By third grade, students are expected to know how to make ten when given one of the addends. For example, if I say 6, the student would say 4. This knowledge aids in addition and subtraction accuracy. Students should also know how to skip count by 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10. This skill will greatly improve their ability to learn their multiplication facts. By fourth grade, students are expected to know their multiplication facts from 0 through 10. Third grade is a critical year. Students are expected to be independent learners. This is necessary for students to be prepared for fourth grade and for the STAAR (State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness) tests. Student success requires both home and school practice. Please help your child practice their multiplication facts daily, help with the homework, and read together.
