- If they have incompletes (big assessments like tests or projects that have not yet been attempted or finished)
- Attendance to school/classes and tardies
- Your child's lunch account to see if they are eating meals

During open house, Kelly Gervais will be available in the MS hallway with some computers to help you get set up with PowerSchool if you would like some help!




