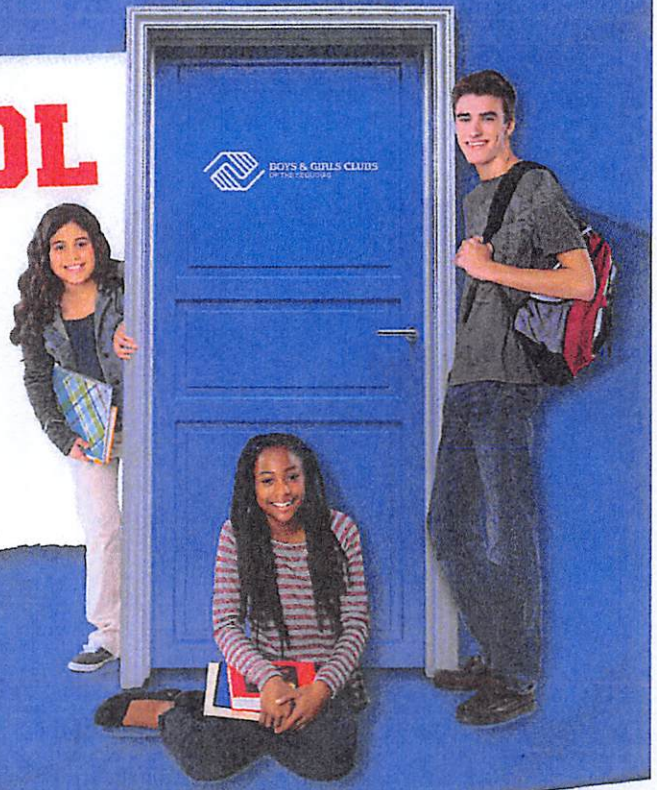

Parent or Guardian Approval of Membership – Please Read and Sign Below

- **OPEN DOOR POLICY:** I understand that the Boys & Girls Clubs of Tulare County, Inc., dba Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sequoias (BGCS) shall have an Open Door Policy. BGCS assumes no responsibility for Members who choose not to come on a particular day or who choose to leave prior to closing. BGCS shall supervise Members on the BGCS premises or any BGCS field trips. It shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to instruct his/her child/member as to arrangements for the child/member to come to and depart from the BGCS. It shall be the responsibility of the parent/guardian to arrange for his/her child/Member to be picked up from the BGCS premises if the parent /guardian does not want the child/member to leave the BGCS on his/her own. Members will not be permitted to return to the BGCS until the following day if the Member leaves prior to closing unless arrangements have been made with the BGCS Site Director. It shall be solely within the Site Director’s discretion as to whether a Member is permitted to return on the same day.
- I understand the Club is not, nor does it claim to be, a licensed day care center.
- I, the parent/guardian of the minor child listed on this application, for ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, hereby release, waive, acquit and forever discharge the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sequoias and Boys & Girls Clubs of America, their representatives, successors, insurers, assigns or any other person or entity associated with any of the above organizations such as staff, directors or volunteers, from all liability, claims, demands, or causes of action for any and all loss, damage, injury or death and any claim of damages resulting from use of facilities owned or controlled by the above organizations, or participation in activities of said organizations either at or away from the Club.
- I give my permission for my child to participate in the Mentoring Program at the Boys & Girls Club. I fully understand that the program involves mentors, who shall be selected from the community and will be screened (including a criminal background check) and trained before beginning the program. A mentor may be appointed to my child to meet on-site at the Boys & Girls Club. The mentor is not allowed to take or meet my child beyond the Club facility.
- I authorize Club personnel, EMT, physician, or hospital to administer emergency medical treatment in the event of an accident or sudden illness.
- I understand my child will be required to do academics while at the club each school day.
- I give my child permission to participate in the Club’s activities within or near the Club’s facility.
- I give my consent to allow my child to be photographed and their picture, without identification, may be used for promotional purposes.
- I understand members who are picked up after closing time may be charged a late pick-up fee of \$1.00 per minute.
- I give my child permission to use the internet under staff supervision.
- I agree to notify the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sequoias if there are changes in the member’s contact information.
- I give my permission to the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sequoias to use my child’s school data for the purpose of club assessments and surveying.

Data Collection/Sharing

- I give my permission to the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Sequoias to collect information via online or written surveys, questionnaires, interviews, and focus groups from the child listed on this application. Any and all information received will be kept strictly confidential. Data gathered through these means will be combined and summarized. Your child’s individual responses will not be maintained or shared. An analysis of the combined responses from all of our members may be shared with Club staff, Boys & Girls Clubs of America (BGCA), funders, and other community stakeholders to show program effectiveness and/or Club impact on our members.
- I give my permission to the BGCS to share information about the child listed on this application with Boys & Girls Clubs of America (BGCA) for research purposes and/or to evaluate the program’s effectiveness. Information that will be disclosed to BGCA may include the information provided on this membership application form, information provided by the child’s school or school district, and other information collected by BGCS, including data collected via surveys or questionnaires. All information provided to BGCA will be kept confidential.

Dress Code

- Have fun, meet new friends, and challenge yourself to be the best you can be.
- Take care of and use appropriately, all Club equipment and facilities.
- Check in and out of the Club daily at the front desk. Follow all program activity rules.
- Stay in supervised areas at all times. Run only in the gym or outside areas.
- Eat food and drinks in appropriate areas and clean up after yourself when finished.
- No chewing gum or sunflower seeds are permitted in any areas.
- Treat others the way you want to be treated: fairly, respectfully, and with courtesy.
- No weapons, including knives of any kind are allowed in the club.
- If you have a problem with another Club member, talk to them or ask a Staff for help.
