What is SSC?: School Site Councils are mandated by the State of California. The basic principle underlying the establishment of the council is that those individuals who are most affected by the operation of their school should have a major role in the decisions regarding how their school functions. This involvement occurs through the development, monitoring, and assessment of a Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA), including a budget, which reflects and supports the plan, and the Safe School Plan.

Who is the SSC?: The council is comprised of the principal, teachers, other school personnel, parents or members of the community, and students.

SSC Responsibilities: The basic role of the SSC is to plan, monitor, and evaluate the activities and expenditures for the Single Plan, and review the Safe School Plan.

The SSC has the opportunity to create effective plans based on the unique needs of its school site. Each council member's input and perspective is important to the success of a SSC as he/she represents that portion of the school community. **Ledesma is looking for three parents to join the SSC committee.**

SSC Meetings: The council currently meets 3-4 times a year, more if needed.
