Research/Writing / Literary Analysis / Strategic Vocabulary Development

Course Description:

This college prep course is also for those who need more individualized help honing their English skills. Topics covered for writing: research, evaluation of sources, outlining, citing, grammar, fluency, reading comprehension, comparing of texts (fiction and non-fiction) and proper format.

Students must write and pass the benchmark essay for that semester of English. Also, we will pilot an individualized SAT prep vocabulary evaluation and strategic memorization computer program called Membean. The program has been used to aid students in the retention of usable vocabulary up through college level. Lastly, we will read and analyze a novel in each semester from that level's genre of literature. Textbooks will be provided.

As prerequisite for taking this class, a student must have earned a "D" or an "F" in a previous semester of English.
