Ever wonder who in Ardmore has been an Ardmore Tiger fan the longest? We think it just might be Martin Dyer.



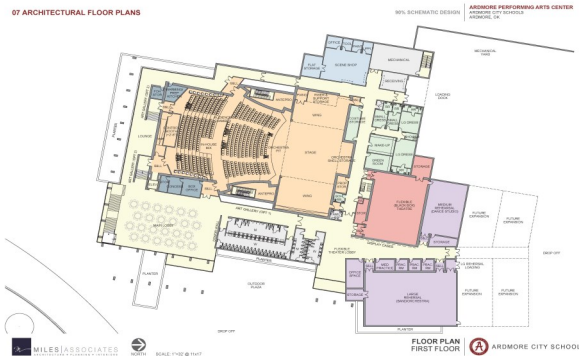
