## **MCHS MISSION STATEMENT**

## **WHAT IS AN EARLY COLLEGE HIGH SCHOOL?**

- Early College High School (ECHS) blend the traditional high school and college into one educational program.
- Students will earn an Associates of Arts Degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from STC while also earning their high school diploma.

## **SUMMER BRIDGE (JUNE 4<sup>TH</sup>- 7<sup>TH</sup> 8:00- 3:00)**

### **Students must attend a Summer Bridge Program.**

- These sessions will prepare students for the college environment. Throughout the year, students are guided to develop productive habits.
- Information on times and dates will be sent home as a reminder.
- Provides students an opportunity to develop the necessary academic skills.

## **ATTENDANCE**

- Attendance is crucial and students must attend every day.
- When taking college classes professors are allowed to drop students with three or more consecutive absences.
- Our funding is determined by our attendance rate.

## **ACADEMIC COMMITMENT**

- Students will be taking Pre-AP, AP and Dual/Concurrent enrollment classes.
- A rigorous curriculum will be implemented to help students be TSI ready so that they may take college level classes and be successful.
- Tutorials will be provided, and students will be expected to attend for enrichment or remediation.
