-Westport Town Scholarship-Open to all Seniors (17 different town scholarships are available). Deadline April 5, 2019. Applications are turned into Mrs. Ruel.

-Massachusetts Shellfish Offices Association. Must be majoring in Biology. Deadline April 5, 2019.

-Cohen and Jaffe, LLP College Scholarship. Open to all. Deadline is April 5, 2019

-Prince Henry Society-Portuguese-American Student Scholarship. Open to any student of Portuguese descent. Deadline April 11, 2019.

-Westport Art Group. Open to students pursuing a degree in the Visual Arts. Deadline April 15, 2019.

-John H. Brown Jr. Scholarship-Dartmouth Grange Open to students pursuing a career that may benefit sustaining our agricultural heritage, our environment or helping to preserve our natural resources. Students who have demonstrated community service and have established academic merit. Deadline April 15, 2019.

-Greater Southeastern Massachusetts Labor Council. Open to students whose parents, legal guardians, aunts, uncles, or grandparents are members of a labor union affiliated with the Greater Southeastern Massachusetts Labor Council. Deadline is April 19, 2019.

-Westport Lions Club: Three scholarships: Prudence and Ernest Chadwick Memorial Scholarship, Harold S. Wood Memorial Scholarship and the Rush Workman/Frank and Brooke McGuigan Memorial Scholarship. One application allows you to be eligible for one of the three. All applications need to be returned to Mrs. Ruel by April 22, 2019

-2019 Mechanics Cooperative Bank Scholarship. Open to students in the top 30% of their graduating class. Deadline April 26, 2019

-2019 Edward J. Sullivan Scholarship-Citizens for Citizens INC. Students must have been a member of one of the following programs administered by Citizens for Citizens: Head Start, After School Day Care, Family Child Care or Extended Day Care. Deadline April 26, 2019.

-Matt T. Benoit Memorial Scholarship- Open to students who represent a strong work ethic, participating in school activities, hold a part-time job and manage their time well-these people represent Matt T. Benoit. Deadline April 27,2019.

-Saint Anne's Hospital-Sofia Carmela M.D. Scholarship Award Open to any student pursuing a degree in nursing, allied health or other health care profession. Deadline April 30, 2019.

-Saint Anne's Hospital-John Arcuri M.D. Scholarship Award Open to students who work for Saint Anne's or have a family member who works for Saint Anne's. Deadline April 30, 2019.

-The Little Theatre of Fall River-The Little Theatre of Scholarship. Open to All. Deadline May 1, 2019.
