## Rank/Grade Point Average:

Class rank and grade point averages are weighted. All Advanced Placement courses will be weighted resulting in a grading scale of 4.333. A student's rank in class is based on her/his grade point average (GPA) which is calculated from all classes taken, grades 9-12. In order to accurately reflect student achievement, summative assessments are the primary source in the calculation of a student's' grades versus formative assessments. Examples of summative assessments are test scores and quizzes, projects, research papers, essays, and performances. Formative assessments (i.e. homework completion, attendance, participation, behavior) are not factored into a student's final grade.

## Schedule

De Pere uses a 7 period schedule with limited options to take an additional 7AM course and a 30 minute Nest/Flex daily.
