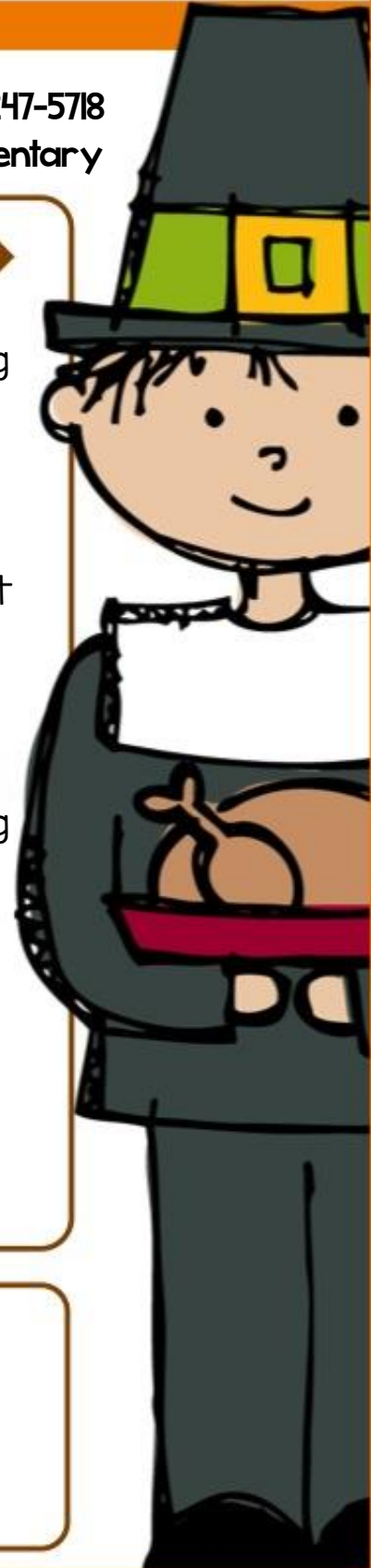

Family Reading Night

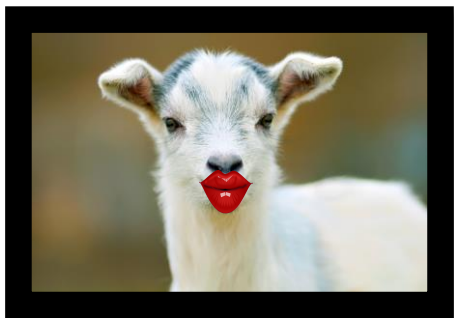
The Rafflemania Basket Auction will be held on December 11th, 5 - 7 pm, in conjunction with Family Reading Night and the Book Fair!
