Committee Reports:

1. PRINCIPAL REPORT

- a. Student Input Review ([Link](#))-Superintendent looking for student voice for interrichment and homeroom time to support student's needs- 6th grade had a lot of input, 7th grade minimum input and 8th grade had deeper discussion, reviewed: lots of social emotional stuff, vaping, alcohol. Will be using to identify topics to talk about in advisory programs, Hawaiian games-more culture and values, bridging the geographic differences through learning about different communities and doing Makahiki games
- b. Review of Master Schedule for [School Year 2019-2020](#)-looking at some accelerated math program changes (called accelerated and no longer honors)- will have pre-algebra and algebra but maybe not geometry), large 6th grade coming in so need another section of all subjects (new 6th position), 4 Kumu to 6 Kumu in Hawaiian Immersion and will offer Hawaiian electives (language and history), reading program (keep it in 6th grade and possible inclusion programming), transition to middle school will replace agriculture and tech courses (yearlong class -to help with organization, digital citizenship, social emotional learning), 8th grade transition to high school class will be digital portfolio project--artifacts from 6th-8th grades, Hawaiiana elective-fishing/tides/Hawaiian crafts/fish identification, High Risk Counselor may become 504 counselor, PBS counselor may not be as effective (push in counseling support has been more successful), need to look at space for in school suspension/behavior challenges, Maui county pulled School Resource Officer (paid by Maui county)
- c. Waiver Days- request 2 additional days(Nov. 1, Jan. 7th) to use as professional development (Nov. school day, Jan. as a Maui Middle school conference). Will complete paperwork and approval signature
- d. WASC Accreditation- once accredited, school credits are accepted at other schools, process includes self-study, committees to review self-study, submit

paperwork, accrediting team comes to review school, documents, meet with teachers, parents, etc. Next school year will begin the process again so will be looking more for parent input.
