KINDERGARTEN

Items to be labeled with your child's name:

1 **full size** backpack (not toddler size and no wheels) large enough to hold a folder, their winter jacket and accessories, and a lunchbox so that we can walk down the stairs hands-free

1 lunch box/bag

1 refillable water bottle that your child can operate independently...please have them practice

1½ inch binder with clear view front...to be returned to you at the end of the year

Items to be shared and do not need to be labeled:

20-50 clear sheet protectors

4-6 [Paper Mate felt tip pens-black](#)

FIRST GRADE

Individual items:

- 3 bound composition books, be careful to purchase the ones that don't have pull-out pages as they fall apart
- 2 **small pencil pouches** (boxes don't fit in all desks) one to hold colored pencils and markers, one for everyday items. These need to last all year, better quality is worth the money.
- 1 **orange plastic** folder with pockets, **NO BRADS!**
- 1 pack clear sheet protectors (30)
- 1 two inch, three ring binder, any color, with clear view front pocket (comes home end of year)
- 1 sock to use as a whiteboard eraser
- 1 large, pink eraser
- Three dry erase markers: two black and one any color you choose except yellow which doesn't show really
- 12 pencils: Ticonderoga only please as the others don't sharpen. Please, no mechanical pencils
- 1 set of paper index or plastic (last longer) dividers for the binder
- 1 set colored pencils (dozen size box)
- 1 set fine (skinny) felt tip markers (small set, 8 or less)
- 1 set fat felt tip markers (8)
- 4 black Bic pens for writing
- 1 small pencil sharpener for colored pencils that holds shavings
- 1 headphones or earbuds in a ziploc bag labeled with name--try them on to be certain they're comfortable. Buy the ones with a microphone so they can be used if "voice typing". They'll be returned at the end of the year.
