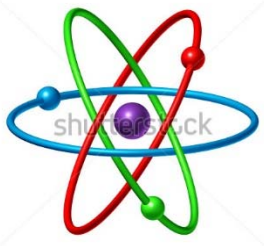

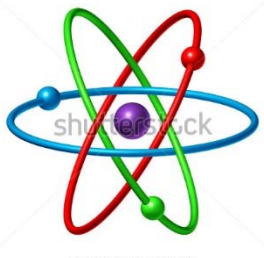
*Congratulations to our new Governance/School Site Council. An election was held at our meeting on Thursday, September 13th. The results are:

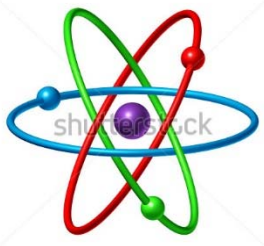
Teachers attended a Eureka Math training from Great Minds. Org. Nestle discretionary funds paid for the trainer and the teachers to attend from 8-3pm. Nestle teachers will be using Eureka Math in place of MY Math. Eureka Math is more aligned with common core standards and better prepares our students to excel on the SBAC assessment in the spring. Our First Grade Team used it exclusively last year with impressive results. I attended the training as well and can attest to the superior curriculum. My only regret is that Eureka Math wasn't available when I was a child.
