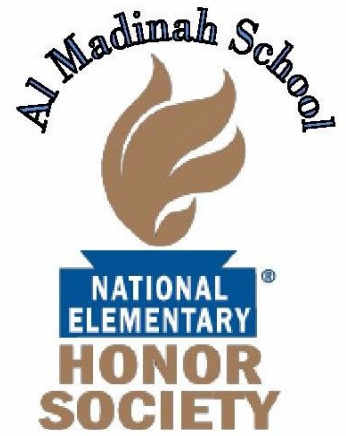


Asalaamualaykum,

NEHS promotes and motivates students to reach their maximum potential in school and life. The Honor Society is grounded in the ideals of scholarship, responsibility, service and leadership.

In order for students to become eligible for the NEHS, we are following the strict guidelines of the chapter. To become inducted as a member and to sustain eligibility students must be in the 3rd, 4th or 5th Grade and:

- Demonstrate proficiency and excellence in all academic subjects including Arabic, Quran & Islamic Studies
- Have good character and moral behavior
- Must be nominated by 2 of his/her teachers
- Maintain a GPA of 4.0 and above
- Must commit to participate in community service projects, in and out of school and demonstrate school spirit and team work.

***Students will have an opportunity to be inducted every spring (April) of each year. NEHS selection is transferable to Middle School and High School.***
