Parent-Teacher Conferences

The Parent – Teacher conference portal is open until November 14th. Our conference dates for grades K-6 are:

Thursday, November 15 -- 5:00 pm – 8:00 pm

Monday, November 19 – 8:00 am – 8:00 pm

Tuesday, November 20 – 8:00 am – Noon

If you have more than one child attending elementary school, be sure to allow for “travel time” to get from one conference to the next.

Below are a few tips to help ensure a successful parent/teacher conference.

1. Talk to your child to find out his or her favorite subjects and activities. Ask if there are any concerns he or she would like you to discuss with the teacher.
2. Be prepared to discuss both your child’s strengths and any areas of need with the teacher.
3. Be on time (or even a few minutes early.) Conferences are often scheduled back-to-back. If there would be a change in your schedule, notify the teacher as soon as possible and, if necessary, reschedule.
4. Remember that conferences are brief. If you find you need additional time, please request a follow-up session with the teacher.
5. Keep an open mind. Remember conferences are meant to help you understand your child’s performance at school. Working together with the teacher will help your child succeed.
6. Make plans. Find out what you can do to follow through at home. Decide together what you, your child, and the teacher can do to help your child be successful.

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Elem. Progress Reports

During the month of November, your elementary child(ren) will receive feedback in the form of a progress report. Progress reports will be distributed to elementary parents during parent-teacher conferences later in November.

Here are some tips to help guide your discussions and minimize the stress levels at home:

- Set aside a time to sit down and discuss the results in private.
- Ask questions about grades, classes, and activities.
- Avoid anger, criticism, blaming, comparisons, and too much praise.
- Focus on positives first; point out achievements.
- As you discuss where your child needs to improve, offer support and encouragement.

Use the progress report as a tool to set academic goals—goals that are challenging but reachable. Have your child list the things he or she is going to do to accomplish these goals. Do not focus on perfection and do not encourage competition against others. Evaluate the activities in which your child is involved; then assist your child in finding a healthy balance between school work and activities by establishing a homework routine, providing special help, and supporting the school. Your attitude and actions as a parent can make a difference.
