

Aiea High School Dress Standard

The Aiea High School Dress Standard was developed to ensure that students dress appropriately for the **school setting**.

Guidelines:

Appropriate attire:

- Students are required to wear their IDs.
- Dresses and muumuus
- Collared shirts, T-shirts, and other tops must cover the midriff and navel. Tops and shirts must have straps over the shoulders and or neck. Shirts and or tops must be worn at all times.
- Pants, capris, overalls, shorts, skirts must be of appropriate length.

(Note: see inappropriate attire)

- Footwear: Shoes, sandals, or slippers must be worn

Inappropriate attire:

- Attire which promotes drugs, gangs or gang activity, sexploitation, discrimination (racial, gender, etc.) profanity or violence.
- No bandanas
- Clothing that exposes underwear and excessive skin.

Examples: "See-thru" sheer or mesh tops, low ride pants that expose the top of the underpants, pants that are inappropriately worn, exposing underwear.

- Clothing that reveals the wearer's midriff, cleavage or breasts, navel or buttocks.
- Tube, strapless or halter tops are not permitted.
