4. If medical or surgical emergencies occur, we hereby give permission to the physician and hospital selected by BGS to take appropriate steps on behalf of the student to do all things necessary to protect the student's health and well-being.
5. We hereby consent to the use of any picture of students for advertising or promotional purposes.
6. I am/my child is in good health and has no health problems that may be detrimental to my/his or her participation in gymnastics or other BGS activities.
7. I/we hereby agree on behalf of myself (and our personal representatives, heirs, executors, administrators, agents and assigns) to indemnify, defend, release and hold harmless BGS (and its affiliates, officers, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assigns) from any and all claims, costs and expenses, (including attorney's fees) or other damages or injuries of any sort which may be incurred or arise out of preparation for or participation in any activities.
