• Learn with Your Child

 - Create a "Graffiti Wall" in a specific spot in your house. Add post-it notes with questions, likes, dislikes, amazing facts, etc. to the wall about your topic. You can even add pictures and answers or hold written conversations!
 - Create a song with the information that you have learned.
