- This is a scholarship to recognize volunteer service, including PTA/PTSA service, in the school and community. **(THIS SCHOLARSHIP AWARD IS SEPARATE FROM THE CALIFORNIA PTA AND ANY PYLUSD HIGH SCHOOL, MIDDLE SCHOOL, OR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PTA AWARDS.)**
- The minimum grade point average qualification is 2.0. However, the applicant's GPA will not be a factor in the review process.
