EXEMPTIONS

In order to establish an incentive, yet maintain student academic preparation for future educational experiences, Stephenville High School offers an exemption plan designed to stimulate students to their very best scholastic efforts. Also, the plan guides students to make good decisions for the real-world situations that call for punctuality and good citizenship.

Who May Exempt

1. **Seniors** may be exempt in all classes for the fall and spring semester finals if criteria are met.
2. **Juniors** may be exempt in four classes for the fall semester and all classes for the spring semester finals if criteria are met.

3. **Sophomores** may be exempt in three elective classes for the fall semester finals and three core (ELA, Math, Science or Social Studies) classes for the spring semester finals if criteria are met.
4. **Freshmen** may be exempt in two elective classes for the fall semester finals and two core (ELA, Math, Science, or Social Studies) classes for the spring semester finals if criteria are met.

Exemptions must meet the following criteria:

1. 90 or above semester average – three or fewer absences in the individual class
2. 80 to 89 semester average – two or fewer absences in the individual class
3. 75 to 79 semester average – one or fewer absences in the individual class
4. 70 to 74 semester average – no absences in the individual class
5. no failing six weeks average per class for the entire academic year
6. completion of all requirements of the class (all assignments turned in)
7. all fines and fees paid prior to exam
8. must not have been truant in that class
9. no disciplinary infractions resulting in the following: • suspension • placement in an alternative classroom setting • placement in ISS
10. no outstanding detention hours
11. must not have missed previous final or semester exams
12. No outstanding attendance hours--
