Welcome, from your Exeter Unified School District's Transportation Department.

We would like to let you know what we offer for Transportation for the up and coming 2018-2019 school year. Exeter Unified School District offers transportation from outside city limits to our five schools, Exeter Union High School 9-12, Kaweah/Alternative Education 9-12, Wilson Middle School 6-8, Rocky Hill Elementary K-5 and Lincoln Elementary K-5.

This year we have five regular home to school routes with various stops throughout our rural/ country areas. We offer transportation to the Boys & Girls Club from Lincoln and Rocky Hill Schools. We also offer a Cross Town bus for our Wilson students from Rocky Hill School and Lincoln School to and from Wilson Middle School. We offer kindergarten transportation from Lincoln and Rocky Hill to The Boys and Girls Club, the Gingerbread House, and Little Lambs day care. Transportation is also offered to certain locations for the HEART after school program from Wilson EDGE, Lincoln, and Rocky Hill.

If you are not sure if your student lives in an area where transportation is provided, please don't hesitate to call our office at 559-592-5573. We will be happy to assist you with any questions you may have. You may also contact us if you are unsure which elementary school your child should be attending or to see if you are located in our School District. Keep in mind that this year we have early release Wednesdays (1:00 PM) the School Buses will run on an early release schedule on these days.

To help ensure the safety of our students and drivers, all of our buses are equipped with cameras that also have audio. All of our route buses are also equipped with seatbelts. Students will be required to wear their seatbelts while riding on the buses.

Please understand that the first week or two of school is always a little bit hectic so we appreciate your patience and understanding while we try to work out any problems we might encounter with routes. We have changed every route for this year. Again, we ask that you please be patient while we work through any issue we come across. You will want to check the District web page to see the changes. If your child has ridden the bus in the past his/her bus, time, or stop could have changed.

As always, our main concern is every child's safety and well being while on a school bus. We look forward to meeting and transporting your children to and from school.
