Minutes of Last LSC: Read and Approved

Business Report: Ned Perisic –

Transfer of funds: SBB/SGSA/NCLB – 10,000 for the math department 10,000 PE department, 10,000 Social Studies (supplies) 115,000 to purchase dell desk top computers for 2 classrooms about 40 computers each 4,000 to buy two laptop carts, 9,000 Server for the whole school, 9,000 for the research reader for the library for the books that we don't have. 30,000 school-wide service contract repairs to strip the whole gymnasium floor and repaint all the lines in the gym. 10,000 to increase the ESP bucket if security needs to stay extra for games etc. this is where the money will come from 1,000 for student transportation.
