IMPORTANT- FOGGY DAY NOTICE

Dear Parents,

As of the date of this notice, and throughout the winter fog season, Firebaugh-Las Deltas Unified School District will operate on foggy day schedules as necessary. The District is part of the Fresno County Superintendent of Schools plan for using radio and television stations to announce delays in school starting times.

On days when there must be a delay, the following procedure will be in effect:

- Breakfast will be served as follows:

Bailey Primary:	9:30 – 9:50 A.M.
Mills Intermediate:	9:30 – 9:50 A.M.
Firebaugh Middle School:	9:00 - 9:27 A.M.
Firebaugh High School:	9:10 - 9:25 A.M.
El Puente High School:	9:10 - 9:30 A.M.

At 6:00 A.M. Television Channel 18 will begin broadcasting the names of school districts which will be delayed. Television Channels 24 & 30 will broadcast the names of school districts with a delay from 6:00 - 7:00 A.M.; Television Channel 47 will broadcast the names of the schools with a delay from 6:00 - 8:00 A.M.

In addition, AM Radio Station KMJ-580 will start broadcasting foggy day schedules at 6:00 A.M.

Announcements will be one of the following - and updated depending on weather conditions:

- PLAN A - 1 ½ Hour Bus Delay
- PLAN B - 2 ½ Hour Bus Delay
- PLAN C - Morning Buses Cancelled
- PLAN D - ALL District Transportation Cancelled

NOTE: Students who walk or have their own transportation to school should try to arrive no later than 9:30 A.M. However, parents are advised to exercise discretion for the safety of their children based upon the fog conditions around their own respective school attendance locations. Students should only be transported to school when conditions become safe to drive.

- Regardless of the length of the Fog delay - school classes will begin at 9:30 A.M. Students who arrive later will be given an excused tardy if unable to arrive on time due to unsafe fog conditions.

THERE WILL BE NO EARLY DISMISSAL ON WEDNESDAYS WHEN SCHOOLS ARE ON A FOGGY DAY SCHEDULE.
