You will READ Chapters 11 and 12 and then take Cornell notes on the content of the chapters. You will then submit your summaries of the chapters on classroom.

  - After taking notes, you will answer each of the DOCUMENT AND MAP questions for Chapters 11 and 12. To be submitted on classroom
