Updates and Reminders:

School Hours: Students may arrive at school at 7:30 am and our school day begins at 7:45 am. If students arrive after 7:45, they will be considered tardy. Monday – Thursday, school ends at 2:45 with dismissal beginning at 2:50. On Friday, our school day ends at 1:45 with dismissal beginning at 1:50. If students arrive after 7:45, they must be signed in at the office before going to class.

Notification of Student Absences: If your child is out sick or not attending school for some other reason, please notify Mrs. McGowan as soon as possible. It is important that we keep accurate attendance information.

Bus Notes: If you are sending a note allowing your child to get off the bus at an alternate location, please provide the name and address of the person who is supervising your child afterschool. This helps the bus drivers make sure your child is getting off the bus at the correct location.

Parent Drop-off and Pick-up: If you are dropping students off in the morning or picking them up from school, please drive around the back of the school building. You'll see a sign indicating the route for cars as you come up our driveway. During arrival and dismissal, cars in the front driveway will hold up our buses. Thanks for your cooperation!

Summer Mailing: You should have received a packet of information from us this summer. If you have not done so already, please return any pertinent information and forms to Mrs. McGowan as soon as possible.
