PUBLIC HEARING ON THE SUFFICIENCY OR INSUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

2018-2019

RESOLUTION REGARDING SUFFICIENCY OR INSUFFICIENCY OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:

Whereas, the governing board of Merced River School River, in order to comply with the requirements of *Education Code* Section 60119 will hold a public hearing on **September 10 2018 at 6:00 o'clock**, which is on or before the eighth week of school (between the first day that students attend school and the end of the eighth week from that day) and which did not take place during or immediately following school hours, and;

Whereas, the governing board provided at least 10 days notice of the public hearing posted in at least three public places within the district that stated the time, place, and purpose of the hearing, and;

Whereas, the governing board encouraged participation by parents, teachers, members of the community, and bargaining unit leaders (if the district or county office has a bargaining unit) in the public hearing, and;

FOR A FINDING OF SUFFICIENT INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS:

Whereas, information provided at the public hearing and to the governing board at the public meeting detailed the extent to which textbooks and instructional materials were provided to all students, including English learners, in the district/county office of education, and;

Whereas, the definition of "sufficient textbooks or instructional materials" means that each pupil has a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home, and;

Whereas, sufficient textbooks and instructional materials were provided to each student, including English learners, that are aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks in the following subjects:

- Mathematics – (Eureka)
- Science - (FOSS-pilot)
- History-social science – piloting materials
- English/language arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program - (Amplify/Core Knowledge Language Arts)

Therefore, it is resolved that for the 2018-2019 school year, the Merced River School District will provide each pupil with sufficient textbooks and instructional materials aligned to the academic content standards and consistent with the cycles and content of the curriculum frameworks. The Public is invited to comment on the Instructional Materials for 2018-2019 at the regular board meeting being held on Monday, September 10, 2018 at 6:00 pm at Washington School.
