If you are tardy to class, you are subject to lunch detention.

Tardies are **NOT** excusable. Tardy students should immediately report to their assigned classroom. Tardy consequences are cumulative. Students must be in their assigned class at the start time of each period.

If tardies are chronic, disciplinary actions are as follows:

- Attendance Agreement (contract)
- If student is enrolled in an extracurricular activity the advisor will be notified and asked to meet with student. This can result in non-participation of extracurricular activities
