## Repetto School Wins 2019 Scholar Dollar Prize

**One of four schools to win \$20K, they will use their prize to develop a Next Generation Science Lab**

*April 9, 2019, Monterey Park, CA* — California's official college savings plan, Scholar Share 529, announced 20 winning public schools in its 2019 Scholar Dollar program. Schools won by garnering the most votes and receive awards ranging from \$5K to \$30K for programs aimed at enriching student lives both in and out of the classroom.

Repetto School was one of four schools in Category C (651 to 900 students), which each receive \$25K. Principal Carin Gasca says Repetto will use the prize to develop a Next Generation Science lab for students to explore science through three dimensional learning.

It took the concerted efforts of the whole community to win the Scholar Dollar Award. Alhambra Unified and Brightwood School thank all those who helped to improve learning opportunities for Brightwood students by participating and thank Scholar Share 529 for their generosity.
