Specific schedules and times for games will be distributed by the coaches according to the league entered. In general, your child should be ready to commit to a 2 to 4 days a week, starting the middle of August and ending in November. Teams may be combined grades. Practices will be held at Clissold or a nearby gym in the community. The teams will compete in various leagues and tournaments in the neighboring communities.

To register for the team:

- **Read carefully** and fill out all requested information on **all forms and sign**.
- **PTA membership is required**. Print and complete the PTA membership form, return it with the membership fee in a separate envelope. **Please pay separately**.
- **Pay by Check or Money Order (NO CASH) payable to Clissold PTA**. The fees are listed on the release form.
- Print and return the completed Release Form with appropriate fees to the school office in an envelope marked **"SPORTS REGISTRATION – ATTENTION: "Girls' Basketball"**
- **Registration ends Tuesday, June 19, 2018.**

The sports program is sponsored by the Clissold PTA, coordinated by volunteers on the PTA Sports Council, coached by volunteer parents, paid for through registration fees, fundraising efforts with the intent of enjoyment by the children.

GUIDELINES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR PARENTS AND PLAYERS

1. The Clissold Sports program is a PTA sponsored activity. Membership in the PTA is required. All players must be students at Clissold.
2. Fees must be paid at the time of registration. A \$25.00 fee will be charged for returned checks. Fees are non-refundable once registration ends and teams have formed. A player will be ineligible for play until all fees are paid.
3. Eligibility: Players must follow the rules established by the school and the coaches regarding grades and behavior in order to remain on the team and have playing privileges. Students who receive a failing grade in any subject will be ineligible to participate in Sports until the five-week progress report indicates a passing grade. Teachers or administration may be petitioned after a two and one-half week period to indicate a passing grade. Students who are suspended from school are ineligible to participate in practices or games on the day(s) of the Suspension. Participation may resume upon returning to school.
4. Following are the guidelines on practice and game time for the Clissold Sports Program and the coaches will do their best to make judgment decisions based on what is best for all players involved.
 - Grades 3-6 should stress instruction. All players who meet team requirements should play at least 33% of game time and equal time during practices and scrimmages.
 - Grades 7-8 should refine skills. Although leagues are more competitive, fairness and sportsmanship should not be sacrificed. All players who meet team requirements should play at least 25% of game time and equal time during practices and scrimmages.

Practices and Games

- Schedule of practices, rules, schedules of games and other information will be distributed by coaches as soon as possible.
 - Every effort must be made regarding promptness and adherence to the time schedules. If there are unavoidable conflicts with games or practices consult with the coach. Absence and tardiness to practices and games will affect the player's game time participation.
 - Practices are for players only. Unsupervised siblings are not allowed at practice.
 - Transportation to and from practices and games is the responsibility of the parents and the players.
 - Each athlete will receive a uniform to keep or to use depending on the sport and the grade level. Proper care of the PTA issued uniform is required and the player must pay for a damaged or lost uniform before he or she can participate in any further PTA activities.
5. Parents must set a standard of respect for their children to follow and are expected to behave in a respectful manner at all times. If you have a problem with a coach discuss the issue with the coach first and if no satisfactory resolution is provided, then address the concern with the parent liaison of the Sports Council as opposed to discrediting the coach in front of your children. Before or after games can be emotional times for both the parent and the coach. Please choose another time to discuss your issues.
 6. Consistent respect by players and parents for team members, opposing team members, referees and property is an absolute requirement. A gross display of disrespect is grounds for disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from the team. Parents may be asked to leave the gym, and barred from future games.
 7. In order to maintain an active sports program additional fundraising activities may be conducted. It is expected that parents and players participate in such activities.
 8. Clissold Sports teams are representatives of our school. Always reflect a positive image.
