LIBERTY HIGH SCHOOL DANCE RULES/ GUIDELINES

- 1) All students must abide by KHSD Ed. Code and Liberty High School rules/policies.
- 2) Involuntary transfer to Continuation, Community, or Suspended Students **will not be allowed**.
- 3) Guests on probation, parole, or pending court date **will not be allowed**.
- 4) All students and guests must turn in a completed Dance Application to Liberty Dean's office before deadline.
- 5) All guests must have a picture I.D. at the door or they will not be permitted.
- 6) All students must present their current Liberty Student ID card at check in. A valid CA driver's license will be accepted for entry in the the dance.
- 7) All students attending the dance will be checked for illegal, unauthorized, or controlled substances prior to entering the dance area; "pat downs" and purse searches will be conducted.
- 8) Students suspected of being under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol will be subject to evaluation and/or a field sobriety test which can include a breathalyzer test.
- 9) Reasonable suspicion can allow any vehicle in the parking and drop off areas to be searched at any time. Dance attendees will be held responsible and given consequences for any unauthorized objects or for any illegal substances in the vehicle.
- 10) Trading or selling of tickets is not allowed. Tickets are non-transferable and non-refundable. Students removed from dance will not receive a refund.
- 11) Any forgery of signatures on this contract will result in the student not being able to attend the dance and future dances for the remainder of the year and subject to further disciplinary actions.
- 12) No students will be admitted 30 minutes after the start of the dance unless prior arrangements have been made with the Dean or Activities Director.
- 13) Students must bring completed contract with Liberty School ID to the Finance Office to purchase dance ticket.
- 14) Students may not leave dance and come back; once students leave, they must exit.
- 15) **INAPPROPRIATE DANCING WILL NOT BE PERMITTED**.
- 16) **Guest must be a current high school student and need administrator approval to attend dance.**

Dancing Guidelines:

- Students hands on partner's hips or in the air, nowhere else. No touching of breasts, buttocks, or genitals.
- No pelvic thrusting/grinding movements.
- No squatting down and dancing. Student's hands cannot be resting on legs.
- Both feet must be firmly planted on the floor. No lying down, kneeling, or hands on the floor.
- No hiking of dresses.

Violations: 1st offense – Warned and wristband cut off. 2nd offense – Removal from dance

Dress code will be strictly enforced; anyone dressed in appropriately will not be admitted into the dance. (If you have any questions about the dress code, please see the Dean of Students.)

Ladies

Appropriate formal attire
Nothing too revealing-dress to cover body
Shoes must be worn at all times
No cutouts in garments that show all of midriff or torso
Under garments must be covered by dress
Dress length must be longer than fingertips length at sides
No bare midriffs (more than 2 inches)
No excessively low cut dresses or tops

Gentlemen

Appropriate formal attire
Tuxedo or suit jacket required
Jacket must be worn at dance
Must wear collared shirt and tie
Tennis shoes in good condition
No blue jeans; Pants worn at waist level
Shirts must be work the entire time
No baseball caps
