BOARD MEETING  
January 8, 2019

**The Bibb County Board of Education met in a Regular Session on January 8, 2019, at 5:00 pm in the Central Office. The Invocation was given by Mrs. Dailey followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mr. McMillan. Roll Call was conducted by Board President, Mr. Mike Oakley:**

Mr. McMillan made a motion to amend and approve the agenda, placing the Executive Sessions: Students (5), at the end of the agenda. Mrs. Dailey seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Jones made a motion to approve minutes from December 11 and December 19, 2018. Mrs. Dailey seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. McMillan made a motion to approve Bills for October 2018. Mrs. Jones seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

October 2018 Financials and Bank Reconciliations were received.

Information regarding Community Service Project of West Alabama, Learn and Earn Employment Program was received.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion for the approval to pay mentor stipends of \$1,000.00 each, less the required applicable fringe benefits, for new teacher mentors meeting the State Department of Education's definition of new teacher. \$500.00 will be paid mid-year, and \$500.00 paid at the end of the year from State Funds received for the purpose. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion for the approval of payment to Mary Beth Brook to conduct West Blocton Middle School Majorette Clinic, March 11-14, 2019. Payment of \$175.00 will be made from WBMS Majorette funds. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Jones made a motion for the approval for 35 West Blocton Middle School 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students, to travel by charter bus to Dauphin Island Sea Lab on March 4-6, 2019, to attend a three day science lab. Teresa Smotherman and Rhonda Smith will travel with approximately 35 students and 12 parent/chaperones. Students and chaperones will stay in a dorm on the sea lab campus. Trip is funded through WBMS local funds. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion for the approval for Randolph Elementary School's 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade students to travel to Chattanooga, Tennessee to see an IMAX movie, visit the Tennessee Aquarium and a Southern Belle Riverboat ride with dinner on the Tennessee River. Students will travel by charter bus departing at 7:00 am and returning by 8:00 pm the same day. The trip is tentatively scheduled for the week of May 6-9, 2019. Trip is funded through RES local funds. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion for the approval for 40 West Blocton Elementary School students, who won a limousine ride and pizza party, to ride in a limousine to Brent Pizza Hut on Friday, January 25, 2019. Students will have parent permission to ride in the limousine. The limousine ride and pizza party will be paid for by Cherrydale, fundraising organization. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mr. McMillan made a motion to accept and approve the resignation of Jonathan Griffin, 12 month Custodian, Centreville Middle School. Effective January 3, 2019. Mrs. Jones seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Jones made a motion to approve the employment of Darel McKinney as Mechatronic/Manufacturing Technology Teacher, Bibb County Career Academy, pending 30 day release from current employer as per Alabama Act 2018-83. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion to approve Jaylon Gaines as Jr High Baseball Assistant Coach, West Blocton Middle School. Effective January 9, 2019. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion. Mr. Oakley said yes. Mrs. Dailey said yes. Mrs. Jones abstained due to conflict of interest. Motion passed.

Mr. McMillan made a motion to approve Lisa Pierson as classroom substitute. Mrs. Dailey seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion to go into an Executive Session- Students. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion to return to regular session. Mr. McMillan seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Jones made a motion for students M.C., A.W., K.M. and T. M., to all be re enrolled into the Bibb County Schools. Mrs. Dailey seconded the motion which passed unanimously.

Mrs. Dailey made a motion to expel student B.H. for the remainder of the 2018-19 school year. Mrs. Jones seconded the motion which passed unanimously.
