Student Behaviour

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1. The school encourages good behaviour motivated by self-discipline and a strong sense of right and wrong.
2. The school should function in an atmosphere of respect and tolerance, fostering desirable behaviour through good example, high expectations and encouragement.
3. The whole school community should be aware of, and be committed to, this policy.
4. Specific examples of good behaviour in students will be commended in a variety of ways.
5. The school will not tolerate any sort of bullying nor any sort of dangerous or disruptive action which may disrupt learning.
6. When school expectations are not met the school will respond with a planned and measured set of actions.
7. External agencies will be consulted as necessary.
8. The school will comply with the appropriate regulations and laws.
(See Behaviour Guidelines.)
9. Parents who are not satisfied with the actions taken by the school should follow the normal hierarchy of talking to the form tutor, departmental head, head of school and school director.
If, after regular communication with the school staff, parents feel that no progress is being made they have the right to take the matter to the Board of Directors or to the SEP. (Secretaría de Educación Pública)
