MEAL DISTRIBUTION

We know that school closures are impacting families differently across our community. Jubilee Academies is committed to helping our families during this closure. The Child Nutrition Department will prepare and distribute meals for children 18 years and younger at several sites while school is closed due to COVID-19 precautions.

Working with the Department of Agriculture we will provide curbside meals to our children. Since our schools are closed, the meals will be “grab & go” so they can be taken home. Children must be present to receive one “grab & go” meal. Due to federal regulations we are unable to provide meals for adults at this time and children will not receive more than one meal per day. Each grab & go meal will include protein, grains, fruit and vegetables. Milk will also be available.

Curbside meal sites will open from 11:30 am-1:00 pm daily and are listed below. At this time meal sites will be open from March 23-March 27. Children are advised to stay in their cars and not enter buildings during meal pick up. Families that walk to the campus will also be served a Grab & Go meal.
