



Holy Name School

ENROLLMENT

Holy Name School is happy to accept all qualified applicants when space permits. While current members of our Parish have priority status, families do not need to be in Holy Name Parish nor Catholic to apply and be accepted. All students are taught Christian values in the Catholic tradition, which is an important part of the education Holy Name provides all of our students. Kindergarten applicants must be 5 years of age by September 1st of the year they begin school.

SCHOOL HOURS

Our regular school hours are 8:00 am to 3:00 pm, with Thursdays being the exception with a 2:30 pm dismissal due to faculty meetings. On the fourth Monday of each month, dismissal is at 12:30 pm due to teacher in-service and professional development days.

CHILD CARE

Extended Care is available both before and after school. Before School Care is provided from 7:00 am to those who enroll. After School Care is provided from dismissal until 6:00 pm to those enrolled. Both are available on a full-time and part-time basis. Enrollment forms will be distributed on the first day of school.

TUITION

All payments made through FACTS, our tuition management company. Two tuition plans are available: Plan A is for those families who support Holy Name School and Parish by assisting with required service hours for the school and contributing financially to Holy Name Parish. Your participation will determine your Plan A - Plan B status. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the school office.

FUNDRAISERS

Since we are actively trying to keep our tuition levels as low as possible, we sponsor a variety of fundraisers to involve the community. We expect our families to participate in these fundraisers, which include a Candy Sale, the International Food Fest, Fright Fest, BINGO events, and the Live & Silent Auction.

SCHOOL SUPPORT THROUGH SHOPPING

At no added cost to you, Holy Name will receive a percentage of the amount you spend on your shopping when you participate in our SCRIP program. Completing the minimum participation requirement should be difficult. A list of options and instructions for registering into the SCRIP program is available in the school office and on the school website

SERVICE HOURS

Since parental involvement greatly benefits a school, we encourage every family to contribute a minimum of 36 hours of service to the school during the school year. (Single-parent families contribute 20 hours). Completion of these hours is one of the requirements to qualify for Plan A tuition.
