

It's Summer! Let's Get Reading!

Contents:

- 1 Book
- 1 Addressed postcard with 2 questions on the back
- Instruction Sheet

Instructions:

- 1 – Students are to read the enclosed book independently if able or with the help of an adult.
- 2 – Students are to thoroughly answer the questions on the back of the postcard in the space provided.
- 3 – Remember to put your name on the postcard!
- 4 – Return the postcard to school by placing it in the mail, bringing it to school or the public library.

Summer Read Alouds:

We are providing read alouds of the books on Tuesdays beginning at 11:30 am at Yadkinville school. Students may come to the school and hear the book read aloud. Parents, students younger than third grade, and siblings can also hear various books read aloud during this time in the media center. The read aloud will take 20 to 30 minutes. It will begin on Tuesday, June 12 and end on August 7. A read aloud will not occur on Tuesday, July 3 due to the holiday.

Additional Postcards:

Additional postcards can be picked up at the school, the public library, and the YMCA. As students read additional books throughout the summer, they may complete postcards for each book. Be sure they fill out the postcard including name, Title and Author of the book, and the two questions. The postcards can be dropped off at the school, public library, or returned the first day of school which is August 20th. If you want to address the postcard to Yadkinville School (305 N. State St. Yadkinville, NC 27055) and place postage on it, you can also mail them back. You can find a list of questions on the school's website for each grade level. Students may also answer additional questions on a sheet of paper and turn that in when school begins back in August.

Prizes:

The number of prizes given will depend on the number of door prizes donated and the amount of money given to the summer reading program. We will award the classroom with the highest percentage of participation a party. The student who correctly and thoroughly completes the most postcards on the books they have read will get a prize. Additional prizes will be given by drawing out postcards from the ones submitted throughout the summer.
