

WEEKEND/SATURDAY CLASSES

The Board of Trustees may provide classes on Saturday in order to meet the academic needs of students.

Weekend classes may include but are not limited to: (Education Code 37223)

1. Continuation classes

Saturday classes also may be used to provide supplemental instruction for students who are failing to meet academic requirements and/or students who desire enrichment in core academic subjects in accordance with law, Board policy and administrative regulation.
