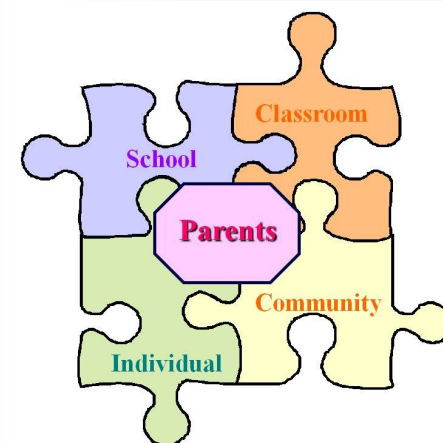

What is Bullying?

- It is an aggressive behavior that involves unwanted, negative actions.
- It typically involves a pattern of behavior repeated over time.
- It involves an imbalance of power or strength.

Our School Rules

1. We will not bully others.
2. We will help students who are bullied.
3. We will include students who are left out.
4. If we know that someone is being bullied, we will tell an adult at school and an adult at home.
