GOALS

GOAL 1: Explain key expectations in the AUTA

If you have a chromebook, you already have signed this agreement. It covers district technology, such as your chromebooks, as well as district electronic resources, such as Wi-Fi.

- Users are responsible for reasonable care of district-issued technology.
- Users are prohibited from attempting to access any content for which they are not authorized.
- Users are not allowed to share passwords.
- Users have no expectation of privacy.

GOAL 2: Explain district-wide expectations for chromebook use

- At all times, students are expected to
 - Adhere to the AUTA and use technology responsibly, ethically, and legally.
 - Bring a fully charged chromebook to school.
 - Take the fully charged chromebook to every class.
 - Follow each teacher's rules related to technology use.
 - Use technology for academic purposes during instructional times.

GOAL 3: Understand chromebook accounts and tracking

Logging in to chromebook accounts

- Students can only use their school email account to log in to a chromebook.

Chromebook tracking

- All RB chromebooks have a tracking system.
- If your chromebook is lost/stolen, report it missing to the office. Then it will be locked so that no one else can use it.

GOAL 4: Understand how to get technical support

If you need help with your chromebook, come to the library before/after school or during lunch or study hall. Your teacher also may decide to send you to the library during class.

If your chromebook is broken and needs repairs, you will receive a loaner.

GOAL 5: Identify how to rent chromebooks

All students are expected to bring a fully charged chromebook to school. If you forget your chromebook, you are still expected to have one for class.

- Go to the business office.
- Rent a chromebook with your ID. The fee will be charged to your student account.
- Return the chromebook to the bookstore between 3:10-3:30. Otherwise, your student account will be charged a daily late fee.
