HOMECOMING, PROM, DANCE AND SPECIAL EVENT DRESS CODE

Seton Catholic High School wants students to make good choices, fostering respect, responsibility and integrity. These events should be fun and memorable but we also want everyone to be comfortable, safe and show Cougar pride. With modesty and safety in mind, the following dress code guidelines will be enforced:

- Dresses may not be cut low at the bust line. Excessive-cleavage is not allowed.
- Dresses may be backless as long as it is NOT cut below the navel.
- Midriffs may not be exposed. This includes both the front and sides of the dress.
- Dresses must not have a slit that exceeds mid-thigh (fingertip length).
- Strapless dresses are permitted.
- No outfit may be skin-tight of hugging the body.
- No pinning may be allowed as an alteration for a dress if, without the pinning, the dress does not meet dress code.
- Dress/skirt length will be no shorter than 3" above the knee.
- Shorts/jeans are not allowed unless it is a special or theme dance.
- Shirts must be buttoned up to the second button from the collar.
- Slacks should fit properly on the hip and not sag below the waistline.

As you begin shopping for a dress/suit/slacks, please keep these guidelines in mind. While we will be reasonable in the interpretation of the guidelines, we want you to know that you will not be allowed to participate in Homecoming, Prom or any other dance if you are not dressed appropriately. *This dress code also applies to guests from other schools.*

*Seton Catholic school administration reserves the right to make the final call whether a dress/outfit is appropriate when students arrive at school dances/event. If administration finds an outfit inappropriate, the student will not be allowed to enter the dance/event.
