



## **Advanced Placement 2014 Scholar Information**

The College Board has released the data signifying the number of Advanced Placement honors for each of our high schools in Columbia County. For the school year ending in June of 2014, we produced 388 Advanced Placement Scholars. The categories are defined below:

- **AP Scholar**-students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams.
- **AP Scholar with Honor**-students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams.
- **AP Scholar with Distinction**-students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams.
- **National AP Scholar**-students who receive an average score of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams.
