Dear Parent/Guardian:

Children need healthy meals every day to grow, develop and be prepared to learn in school. Lakeview Public Schools offers healthy meals every school day through our food service department. Students may buy an elementary lunch for **\$2.75**, middle & high school lunches for **\$3.25** and breakfast at any school for **\$1.50**. The purchase of milk only is available at a cost of \$0.50. Paying for lunches is easy by utilizing our on-line payment system or by sending cash or checks to school periodically. Each student can have an account established that will allow daily purchases without the use of cash in the lunch line. We encourage each family to check out the link to this service on any school website and look for more information at the start of the school year.

In addition, as a result of federal and state government support, some children may qualify for free meals or for reduced price meals. For families who qualify, Lakeview also sells reduced price lunches for \$ **0.40** and breakfasts for \$ **0.30**. I encourage you to review the attached Question and Answer document to help you understand more about the food service department's options for menu choices and qualifying for the reduced, or free, meals program.

Lastly, for your convenience and if you would like to expedite the processing of your child's lunch application, please complete an online application at www.lunchapp.com, select Lakeview Public Schools in St. Clair Shores, MI. (Note: There are two other "Lakeview" districts in the State of Michigan, so be sure to select the correct one.)
