Position Title:	Middle School RTI Interventionist
Reports To:	Director of Schools
Job Goal:	Provides information, support, for middle school staff with RTI.
Term of Employment:	10 months

Responsibilities: (Include but are not limited to)

- Coordinate/monitor/implement RTI (Tiers 2, 3) instruction & interventions in grades 6-8 for ELA & Mathematics.
- Conduct RTI fidelity checks for all ELA & Mathematics instructors and interventionists in grades 6-8 as determined by the OSSD RTI Plan.
- Spend time each week monitoring RTI programs, conducting classroom fidelity checks, analyzing student data, and adjusting student interventions/placements to ensure student success.
- Collaborate with the school's support team (S-Team) to ensure students' placements in interventions are appropriate and effective.
- Communicate with parents of students in interventions in order to ensure their understanding of their child's progress.
- Collaborate with the Middle School Principal and the Assistant Director of Schools to ensure the overall RTI program is being implemented in an effective, efficient, and appropriate manner.
- Be evaluated with the TEAM School Services Personnel rubric as required.
- Any other duty/responsibility as assigned by the Director of Schools or his/her designee.

- Valid Tennessee Professional Teacher's License or Administrator's License;
- Teaching experience in an ELA or Mathematics classroom;
- The ability to analyze data and create plans to address areas of need;
