Carpool Reminders

As Principal of Our Lady of Guadalupe School, I am quite concerned that a few in our community are not cooperating with our safety rules. This is particularly noticeable in the afternoon pickup lines. There are only two manners for picking your child up safely. We had the La Habra Police Department assist us in determining these procedures.

1. You may pick your child up via our carpool lines. One line enters through the lower gate off of Third and Marian Street. The other line is **double** from the front gate out to La Habra Blvd. The two lines should be side by side until they enter the front gate. The lines MERGE like a zipper as they enter past our front gate. Some parents line up quite early but if you arrive between 3:05 and 3:10 your wait will be very short.
2. You may park your car and walk to Jason's Patio at the church. If your child is a "walker" they should know to walk out at @3:05 with the assigned teacher. You will meet the group and take your child by the hand to your car.
3. NO PARENT or GRANDPARENT may stand by the pedestrian gate or enter the pedestrian gate by the Parish Office. Teachers will not cross children at that point. Please honor this.
