5. CCSD Corrective Action for school year 2017-2018

Dr. Konold explained that the only thing that needs to be corrected from last school year is adding one more licensed teacher to the governing board. There was discussion on a few people that could possibly serve. This new member will need to be discussed at the next board meeting.

6. Administrator's Report

Mr. Congleton spoke about how the school has added an extra 6<sup>th</sup> grade teacher and class to be able to serve more middle school students. The school was able to put in a new PE facility on the property and section off a new classroom for that PE class. Mr. Congleton was happy that the school has more kids in the day school program than ever and things are transitioning smoothly with few behavior issues. The teachers are working well with each other and the students. Because of the Global Charity grant that Dr. Konold was able to get, the school is able to offer an extra hour in the school day which gives the kids more opportunity to earn their credits. Mr. Congleton is hoping to receive knowledge from the training on the star rating in order to keep the school progressing in the right direction.

Mr. Congleton mentioned that our summer school program was very successful and we were able to serve over 30 schools in the district. The school's credit recovery program continues to help credit deficient students throughout the school year. The Delta Academy's full-time Behavior Specialist continues to be helpful in serving the student's mental and emotional needs.
