

## OPEN LEARNING CENTER (OLC)

**Goal:** To help struggling students develop and maintain good study habits. The OLC will provide an opportunity for students to stay after school to get assistance/tutoring, have a quiet place to study, make up tests and be provided access to computers. The OLC also targets students who are struggling with completing homework. Students may drop by the Open Learning Center during the school week when available.

**Behavior:**

1. All Code of Conduct rules apply.

## TUTORING

**Multi-Purpose Period (MP<sup>2</sup>)** - during this period, three days a week, students, with a pass from their teacher, can receive additional help in a subject area from that teacher. In addition, students can be tutored by their peers through the NHS tutoring program.

**Teachers (before and after school)** - students may contact their individual teachers to arrange a time before or after school to receive additional help in a course.

**Tutors** - the school district maintains a list of individuals who are interested in tutoring students. Parents must make their own arrangements with these individuals. The district does not endorse those on the list.

**ELL** - Support/tutoring for ELL (English Language Learners) students, twice per week with an ELL instructor.
