Reminders:

- A signed permission form must be turned in upon purchasing a ticket. Permission forms will be available beginning May 1st in room 47 from 11:15am to 11:50am.
- Tickets available for purchase from April 30th to May 28th in room 47 during lunch or afterschool.
- Grad Nite participants will leave from SJVA on May 31st at 8am and arrive back at SJVA on June 1st @4:45am.
- Students are required to travel on our school bus and return on our school bus.
- After arrival at SJVA on June 1st, participants are responsible for their own transportation from SJVA to their residence.
- Grad Nite is at Disneyland. **Price is \$150**
- Backpacks, bags, and other personal items will be subject to search by staff and Disney Amusement Park personnel.
- No outside food or beverages. Students can bring empty water bottles to fill up at the park, but no other liquids are allowed; including perfumes.

- Please observe the rule of **NO noisemakers, silly string, confetti launchers or poppers during the ceremony**. We want everyone at the ceremony to have the opportunity to hear and enjoy the ceremony without interference.
- **If you bring balloons you will be asked to leave them at the gate until after the ceremony.**
- Cake and desserts will be served immediately after the ceremony.
- **IMPORTANT:** Students who borrowed the Cap and Gown must return the items at the end of the ceremony. You may keep the tassel.
- There will be a professional photographer taking pictures throughout the entire ceremony.
