2. Requirements of Federal Law

This services plan is provided to comply with federal law for students with disabilities enrolled by their parents in private schools or facilities within the boundaries of a public school district. This means that students aren't entitled to the same level of services that public school students receive. The district remains ready, willing and able to develop an Individualized Education Program (IEP) and provide a free appropriate public education upon this student's enrollment and attendance in public school.
