- Live Scan FBI/DOJ results received & cleared by TVCS Administration by March 2, 2020.
- Volunteer requirements completed by March 2, 2020.

Parents interested in participating (1 parent per child) must have completed all requirements of the TVCS Volunteer Handbook & Application, including Live Scan results received and cleared by administration and attending a volunteer induction meeting, by no later than March 2, 2020. **We recommend having a Live Scan done ASAP as we have no control over how soon the results are reported to us.** If you've already had a Live Scan done for TVCS you will not need to have another one. Parents are not required to be TVCS field trip drivers. All volunteer forms are located under the PARENTS tab of the school website (www.tvcscougars.com) Induction meeting sign-ups are also located on the front of the website under the Latest News section.

Parent chaperones will be in charge of assisting student groups and helping the Indian Hills staff with the activities. Parents should be prepared to be actively engaged with all students and staff while on this trip. Sleeping accommodations are in wagons/cabins.
