Homework Help

Math: We will be completing the front side of our math workbook pages in class each day and I will be sending home the back of the worksheet for homework each night. Please check for right answers as you review homework with your child. If they do not understand a concept, please write a little note on the paper so that I can give extra practice to them and give additional help to them in class. Thank you.

Flashcards: Please review fact families all the way through the 18 family. If you do not have a set of WCA flashcards, you may purchase a set through the front office. You may also use any other set of flashcards or websites with fact games. These facts need to be mastered because we will quickly be moving into multiplication and division review. You may choose to go ahead and review multiplication and division cards for the 0,1,2,3,5 and 10 families that were taught in second grade.

We will also be making flashcards for reading, science, and Bible using our notecards. Third grade is a foundational year for learning study skills. We are excited to come alongside you and teach these crucial study skills that will train students for a lifetime of success! I would encourage you to study flashcards each night and that way when the test rolls around, your child will already be prepared. Flashcards will be found in Ziploc bags in the accordion folder.

English: Workbook pages will be completed individually in class. Once completed, students follow along as we check their workbook pages to clarify any questions and correct mistakes. These workbook pages are great to review for the tests. English textbooks can be brought home to study from, but must be brought back to class the next day. Rereading/reviewing the chapter and workbook pages are good study tools!

Science: Workbook pages will be completed individually in class. Once completed, students follow along as we check their workbook pages to clarify questions/correct mistakes. Geography: We are working with maps, globes, and atlases this year in Geography and will be completing hands on activities in class as well as written work. We will also be completing some projects with this new curriculum.

Accordion File Folder: Please DO NOT remove any papers to keep at home unless they are in the parent pocket folder.

The papers or notecards may be taken out to review or study for a test but PLEASE put them back in the folder because we use them in class each day. If there are any papers in the parent pocket, please remove them and keep them at home. Thank you!

Quizzes: Pop quizzes will be given in class and some class assignments will be graded as well as some homework assignments. Please encourage your child to ALWAYS do their best.

Reminders: Your child will bring home an assignment tablet each night with their homework assignments for the night as well as their test schedule for the week. This is your child's responsibility. They are responsible for writing their assignment in the morning, taking their assignment pad home, getting your signature that they completed their homework, and bringing their assignment pad back to school. **Pink slips will be given if any of this is not completed.**

Uniforms: Accessories such as bracelets, necklaces, and scrunchies are not allowed. A small cross necklace may be worn and tucked into shirt. NO smart watches are allowed. A small watch may be worn but it must not be capable of beeping; this is a big distraction in class. Thank you for understanding.
