What is Title I?

- Eligible to any school with **40%** or more students on free and reduced lunch
- EES is currently at **19.4%** Free and Reduced lunch, so in order to keep funds, we need all who are eligible to apply
- Allows students who qualify to have **free or reduced lunch** as well as **field trip fund assistance**
- Benefits include more than free and reduced lunch. Program comes with a significant amount **federal money** to help pay for items in the right hand column
- Funds are used to serve **ALL children** in order to increase academic achievement
- Goal= to assist students in achieving grade level standards in **reading/language arts** and **math** and **closing the achievement gap** between all students
